WHO

We are looking for adult (21+) cochlear-implant listeners who have been activated for at least 6 months to participate in ongoing experiments on auditory perception with the cochlear implant.

WHAT

The experiments involve listening to brief tones, beeps, or speech samples. Subjects are asked to identify speech tokens, detect subtle differences between sounds, or to make judgments about the comparative loudness or pitch of different sounds.

WHEN

We would require a minimum block of 2 hours of your participation at a time, with breaks whenever needed
