Two-word semantic rules

- Nomination: Demonstrative + X
 - That ball; This kitty
- Attribution: X + attribute *or* attribute + noun
 - Ball red; kitty nice *or* pretty boat
- Possession: Possessor + possession
 - My dolly; Daddy shoe
- Location:
 - X + location
 - Doggie bed; dolly chair
 - Action + location
 - Put table; throw me

Two-word semantic rules

- Actor-action
 - Agent + action
 - Doggie sit; kitty eat
 - Agent + object
 - Daddy cookie; mommy shoe
 - Action + object
 - Drink juice; throw ball
- Requests or imperatives
 - Verb + object
 - Want milk; gimme ball
 - Recurrent/quantifier + X
 - More up; more juice; 'nother milk

Two-word semantic rules

- Plurality - quantifier + noun
 - Two cup
- Questions
 - Yes/no
 - Wh: What dat?
- Negatives
 - Nonexistence
 - Nomore light; no hot
 - Rejection
 - No carrots
 - Denial
 - No morning

Stress hierarchy

- New information
- Locative
- Possessor
- Noun object
- Action
- Pronoun object
- Agent

Longer utterances

- [agent+action] + [action+object] = **agent + action + object**
Mommy drink Drink juice Mommy drink juice
- [agent+locative]+[action+locative] = **agent + action + locative**
Mommy throw Throw me Mommy thrown me
- [action + object] --> [action + (attributive+entity)]
Eat cookie Eat big cookie
- [action + locative] --> [action + (possessor + possession)]
Sit chair Sit Daddy chair
